Eligibility:

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the as <u>4 Yr. B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Honours</u> with or without Research) & <u>3 Yr. B.A./B.Sc./B.Com (MULTIDISCIPLINARY</u>) courses, <u>aggregate</u> <u>marks</u> shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate <u>provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.</u> However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/ Studies (ENVE) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (General) only (without taking Education, Economics and Geography as combination subject).

The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination in 2020, 2021,2022 and 2023 are eligible for admission.

Pass in a subject means 30% marks in both theory and practical (if applicable).
